Equipment Loan Service

It is the borrower's responsibility to ensure that all usernames and passwords are kept separate from the equipment.

Laptops

- Login with a generic username and password so no access to personal / departmental network drives.
- Access to Microsoft packages – Word, Excel, Publisher, PowerPoint etc.
- Access to the internet using Trust Wi-Fi on-site and personal Wi-Fi off-site.
- Access to NHS.net and personal email but not Trust Webmail.



Laptops are not supplied with memory sticks or blank CD/DVDs

iPad

- Apple iPad in box, cable and two part plug



Headsets

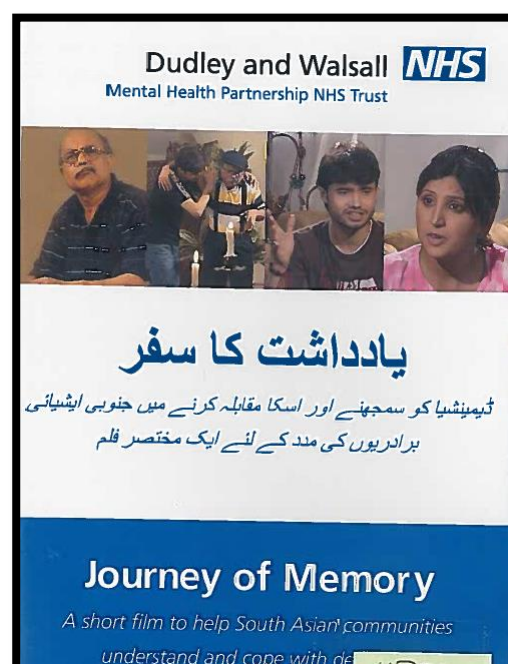
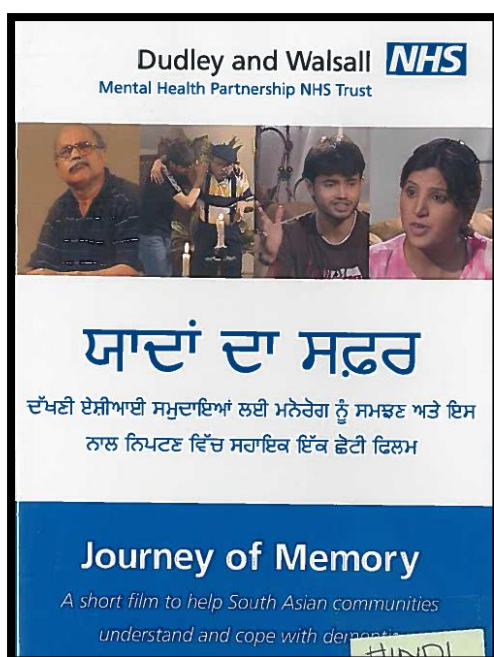
