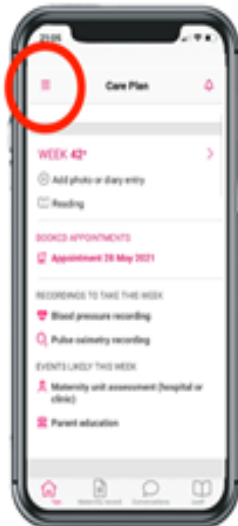

Badger Notes

How Does It Work?



Care Plan

- The app displays a week-by-week view of your care plan (planned between you and your midwife).
- Scroll up and down to see what to expect across the different weeks of your pregnancy (informed by NHS Choices).
- Easy access to your appointment notes

Maternity Record

- View extracts of information direct from your medical record
- View the members of your care team
- Watch the 'Antenatal care summary' report grow into a chronological record of some of your key pregnancy events

Conversations

- Submit your thoughts and questions about your antenatal care, birth plan and postnatal care to your midwife - she will review this with you at your next scheduled visit.

Leaflets

- View your hospital's full library of pregnancy leaflets

Badger Notes

When meeting your midwife, you will be asked to consent to using the new Maternity Notes app as a way of 'carrying' your pregnancy notes. **This replaces the hand-held pregnancy notes.**

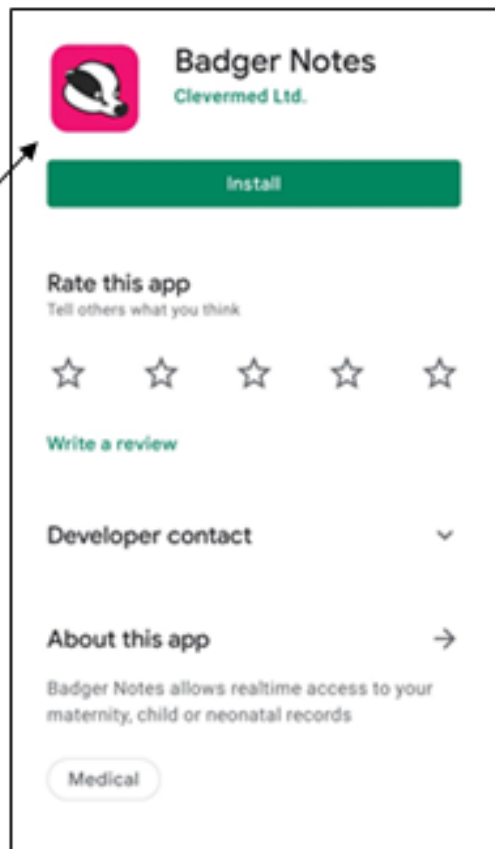
This guide will walk you through how to log onto the application:

Downloading the app

Open the app store on your smartphone and search for 'Badger Notes'. Click the app with this icon:



You may access the app before your first midwife appointment if you have been given your unique passcode. Your midwife will give this to you when she first makes contact.

The app will then send a verification code to the mobile phone number you gave to your midwife when consenting for the Badger Notes application.

Please enter the code into the verification screen.

The app will then request you to create a pin code.

Unless you get logged out of the app completely, this will be how you get access to your Badger Notes

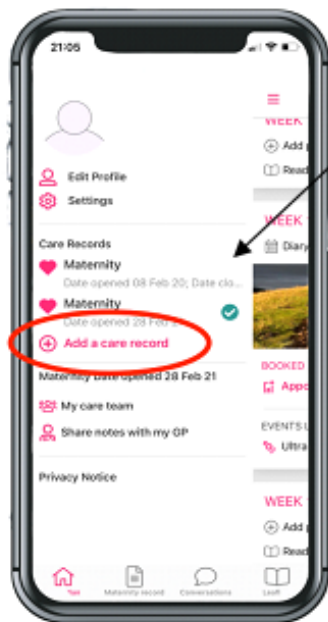
