

If your baby has any of the following signs of infection, call 999 immediately:

- Any change in colour to very pale, blue or dusky
- Difficulty breathing (noisy grunts, rapid breaths, ineffective breathing, pauses between working hard to breathe)
- Regular jerking of the arms and legs like a fit

Signs of infection in a new baby include:

- Extreme tiredness/lethargy
- Irritability
- High-pitched or abnormal cry
- Poor feeding
 - Floppiness
 - Grunting or difficulty breathing
 - Abnormally high >37.5°C or low <36°C temperature
- Rash or sores on the skin, eye or inside the mouth

If you are concerned your baby has an infection, seek medical assistance as soon as possible.
