



How To Set Up Translation On Google Chrome Web Browser

1.) Open a up to date Google chrome browser then click the 3 dots in the top right-hand corner of the screen.




2.) Select 'Settings' from the menu.





3.) On the left-hand side of the menu select 'Languages'.



4.) In the centre pane, click 'Add languages'.





7.) Now tick the box that says 'Display Google Chrome in this language. (You will notice the preferred language will then go to the top of the list)




8.) Now click 'Relaunch' and your browser will change to the preferred language selected. Please note this will only change the language of the google chrome browser to change the language of a website page.




