Modules:

• Building the Foundations

This introductory module will help you to assess your current level of skill, ensure that you are searching for information in the right place and develop a simple search strategy.

• Developing the Skills

This module supports you to use a range of searching techniques which will help you find relevant articles quickly and easily. You will learn how to narrow and broaden your search to ensure that you find the right amount of information.

• Applying the Skills

This final module brings your learning together, providing the opportunity to apply the techniques learnt in the previous modules to search the NHS Knowledge and Library Hub. It also signposts you to additional bibliographic databases for more advanced searches.
