A makeover for the **Discharge Lounge**

Tattooing service returns for breast cancer patients

A nipple tattooing service for breast cancer patients is now back up and running at Walsall Manor Hospital, after being paused during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Funding from Well Wishers meant that patients no longer had to travel out of the borough for this treatment - a treatment that proved important for the confidence and wellbeing of some patients affected.

The charity funded refresher training sessions for all staff previously involved.

New look playroom gets the thumbs up

Bright, colourful walls, activity tables, new toys and a wet play area are just what the doctor ordered for young patients on Walsall Manor Hospital's Children's Ward

And they gave their new playroom a big thumbs up when its £23,000 transformation was unveiled, watched by many of the fundraisers who had helped its makeover.

Walsall Healthcare's Well Wishers charity funded the work on the tired play space with thanks to the donations from the supporters of the charity's appeal. They worked with the ward's Play Specialists to create the new look feature
