


# HCP 0-19 Service

## Health Visiting School Nurse Teenage Pregnancy

Within our HCP0-19 Service we have several teams working together to support families from pregnancy until their young person is 19 (25 for a young person with additional needs).



### Teenage Pregnancy Team

The team offers support for teenage parents aged 13-19 (up to age 25 for those with special educational needs or a disability) and targeted intervention to prevent teenage pregnancy.

### Medical and Premature Pathway - MAPP Team

The team offer tailored support for parents/carers of premature infants and infants/children with medical needs.

### Infant Feeding Team

The team are here to provide specialist support during your feeding journey to help you attain your goals.

### Family Hub Team

Tailored support to help infants, children, young people and their families to have the best start in life.

### Health Visiting Children In Care Team

The team supports children under the age of 5 who are either living with parents on a court order, are in foster care, or in a pre-adoptive placement within Walsall.

### Vulnerable Team

The team offer health support to families with children who are refugees, migrants and asylum seekers. They provide health support to families fleeing domestic abuse, families living in temporary accommodations and families subject to safety plans.

### SEND Team

Supporting children, young people and their families with special educational needs, development and disabilities up to 19 years of age (25 years for some children).

### Strengthening Families Team

Tailored support to help infants, children, young people and their families to have the best start in life.

### Health in Pregnancy Team

Supporting preparation into parenthood, guidance on infant/parent relationships and early child development.
